

The following lists give suggestions of what trees, shrubs, and flowers deer like and dislike.

Deer PREFER to eat the following trees, shrubs, flowers, or plants.

Apple, Hackberry, Daylily
Azalea, Hydrangea, Hawkweed
Basswood, Rhododendron, Hosta
Birch, Sandberry, Lily
Bur Oak, Siberian Crab, Strawberry
Chokecherry, White Cedar, Tulip
Cotoneaster, Yews, Impatiens
Dogwood, Violet
Green Ash

Deer SOMETIMES eat the following trees.

Amur Maple, Highbush Cranberry
Black Cherry, Ironwood
Boxelder, Mountain Ash
Bush Honeysuckle, Rose
Cottonwood, Scotch Pine
Elm, Sumac
Forsythia, White Pine
Hazelnut, Wild Plum

Deer generally DISLIKE the following trees, shrubs, flowers, or plants.

Barberry, Achillea, Penstemon
Buffaloberry, Ajuga, Peony
Fir, Allium, Poppy
Gooseberry, Bleeding Heart, Snow-on-the-mountain
Honeysuckle, Cone Flower, Speedwell
Juniper, Coral Bell, Yucca
Lilac, Coreopsis, Alyssum
Nanking Cherry, Cranesbill, Begonia
Nannyberry, Daffodil, Forget-me-not
Ponderosa Pine, Ferns, Marigold
Potentilla, Flax, Periwinkle
Raspberry, Foxglove, Polygonum
Russian Olive, Gayfeather, Primula
Spirea, Lamb's Ear, Salvia
Spruce, Lily-of-the-valley, Snapdragon
Western Yellow Pine, Lupine, Zinnia
Western Red Cedar, Monkshood, Pachysandra
